
Student Tutorial: Moodle Forums (Reply)


- 1. Best Practice: Before you log into Moodle you must have cookies enabled. If you are using **Internet Explorer** the default setting is for cookies to be disabled and the result is the server will not record your answers and you will get ZERO credit. It is generally safer to use the **Firefox** web browser because it *normally* defaults to accepting cookies. * DO NOT USE **SAFARI** WEB BROWSER *

5. A new window will appear displaying all available **Forums**.








8. To **REPLY** to someone's post, Click on the title(s) under **DISCUSSIONS**.




9. Example:




10. Once you have selected and clicked on a title under **DISCUSSIONS**, a new window will appear displaying the posting



11. To **REPLY** to this post click on the word Reply.




12. Once you have clicked REPLY, a new window will appear with a text editor. **HERE YOU WILL POST YOUR REPLY.**



• These tools allow formatting for your text.



13. Once you have typed in your Reply, click on **Post to forum** button.



14. After you click on **Post to Forum** button a new page will appear indicating that you have <u>30</u> minutes to make any changes to your Reply.



• Click on continue OR wait, a new page will appear displaying your **REPLY** and the **POST** you replied to.



15. To EDIT or DELETE your reply, click on the desired action word link.



• The **EDIT** and **DELETE** options are visible and can be used until time allowed for editing has expired.
